The minimum package for students entering the 2024-2025 academic year offers five contiguous years of support that includes a Student Academic Appointment (SAA) in the form of a teaching or research assistantship with a stipend of at least \$26,550 per year (\$23,000 for the 10-month academic year and \$3,550 for the summer). Student Academic Appointees (SAA) are expected to spend approximately 20 hours each week on their assigned duties or projects. The appointment also includes a fee remission which waives tuition (currently worth \$39,915.30 for a non-resident), student health insurance (currently worth \$3,458.59) and fees (mandatory and course related). The annual stipend paid to teaching assistants is considered taxable income, and it is our understanding that the tuition remission is non-taxable. Please note that a summer assistantship requires students to be on campus during the summer semester (6-8 weeks) while serving as a teaching assistant (TA).

Of the graduates in the 2014-2022 window, 72% are licensed. Many of our graduates are in research jobs where licensure is not required, so they do not apply for it. Of the students in the 2014-2022 window who sought licensure, 100% were successful in obtaining it.
